- No changes can be made to the submitted paper abstract after the submission deadline.

All abstracts must be received by **19th June 2019** and must be submitted to secretariat@knascience.org

Response on selected abstracts for both oral and poster presentations will be **21st June 2019**.

Instructions to Presenters

All authors should ensure that their papers focus on the pertinent issues, policies, and interventions necessary to address the themes. A report will be produced and shared with all the presenters.
